

- \* Improve community outreach about and demand for basic and comprehensive emergency obstetric and newborn care services.
- \* Upgrade facilities to offer these services
- \* Expand voluntary blood donation services to address needs associated with the expansion of emergency obstetric care.

#### **GOALS**→

- \* Transition the country from a low to a middle-income economy
- \* Reduce maternal and neonatal mortality in key regions by 20 percent by June 2018
